KEY ACTIVITIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS:

 Distributed education kits to 356 children, including school bags, notebooks, and stationery supplies.



Distributed non-food items to 687 families, including kitchen sets consisting of gas stove and lighter, pressure cooker, cooking bowls, frying pan, serving plates, bowls, spoons, glasses, storage container, knife, and kitchen dustbin.
