EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND EARLY RECOVERY FUND (EREF) IN INDONESIA

The EREF in Indonesia covered the two most recent major disasters in the country, the Lombok earthquakes and Lembata flood, specifically in West Nusa Tenggara (NTB) and East Nusa Tenggara (NTT). The combined total funding was USD 198,671 and the responses reached a total of 14,032 people.

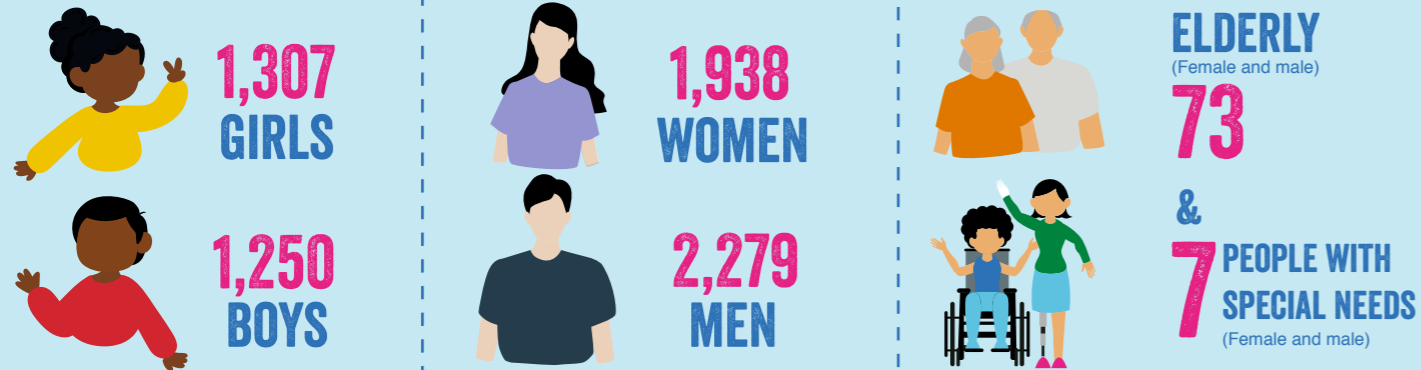

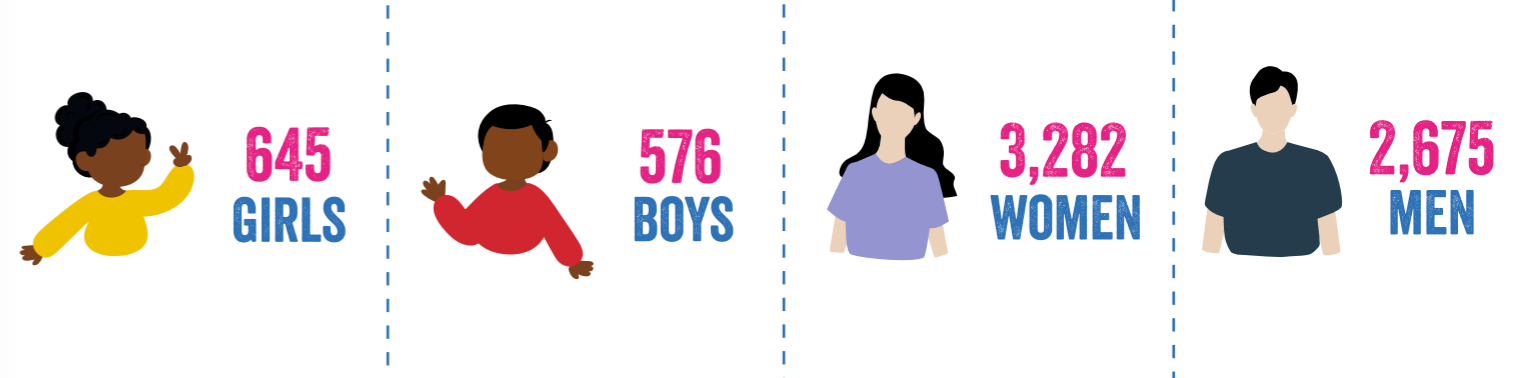

KEY ACTIVITIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS :

- Established water, sanitation, and hygiene facilities



KEY ACTIVITIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS :

- Distributed 1,250 non-food items, including COVID-19 prevention kits, mosquito nets, and hygiene kits.
- Distributed 500 shelter kits.



- Distributed recreational kits.
- Distributed 1,221 school kits to children.
