
HYGIENE KIT DISTRIBUTION FOR COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE

The COVID-19 pandemic is causing devastating economic and social disruption all over the world. The Bangladesh Rural Advancement Committee (BRAC) stated that 75% of people in rural areas are at risk of falling into extreme poverty. The situation affected the ability of people in rural areas to meet their basic needs. To support families in battling COVID-19, Plan International Bangladesh has distributed 4,450 hygiene kits to targeted households under the ICDRM project.



HYGIENE KIT PACKAGE DISTRIBUTED PER FAMILY

- 1 kg Detergent Powder
- 10 Bathing Soap
- Packages of Sanitary Pads
- Plastic Jug (with 3.5 liters capacity)
- Plastic Bucket with lid and tap (with 20 liters capacity)
- Masks (3 layers of cloth)

Additional distribution:

- 52 sets of PPE (gown, mask, safety goggles, head cover, gloves, shoe covers and socks) for 26 health workers.
- 13 hand washing machines for 10 Community Clinics and 3 Family Welfare Centers
- 4,000 masks for 500 most vulnerable shop keepers.
